Literacy (reading, writing, spelling and handwriting)

- Articulate and justify answers and opinions
- Blend letter sounds, including alternative patterns, e.g. recognising 'ue' as the 'oo' sound
- To read words that do not follow a phonetic pattern
- Become familiar with a wide range of familiar fairy-tale stories and traditional tales
- Check that what has been read makes sense
- Form letters of the appropriate size, using capital letters where appropriate
- Use question marks, exclamation marks, apostrophes and commas in lists
- Use the present and past tenses correctly in writing
- Spell longer words by breaking them into their sound parts

Numeracy

- Read and write numbers in numerals and words
- Count in 2s, 3s and 5s
- Compare and order numbers, including the use of < > signs to represent the relative size of numbers
- Recognise that addition and subtraction are inverse operations
- Learn the multiplication and division facts for the 2x, 5x and 10x tables
- Use the x symbol in multiplication
- Find 1/4, 1/2 of an object or set of objects
- Tell the time to the nearest five minutes on an analogue clock
- Know the number of minutes in an hour and hours in a day
- Identify the number of faces, edges and vertices on 3-D shapes

Units:

Who am I?

- We will learn what we can do well, how we can celebrate each other's differences whilst also seeing things in common, and research where we come from
- We will think about how we can stay safe, how we can deal with anger and what makes us feel happy
- We will look at how we can stay fit and healthy, how our heart works and different types of food

The Earth

- We will learn about living things (plants, animals and humans) and how living things need a home, which we call a Habitat
- In science, we will learn about plants and animals living in forests, different types of trees and how we can sort living things into different groups
- We will learn about micro-habitats, how animals adapt to their environments and how living things depend on each other
- In technology we will research habitats and design and create a nesting box
- We will look at how we can help our planet through learning about the world's forest and Earth Day

Home learning and Communication diary/reading records

Children will be given homework on a Sunday and a Tuesday and should complete the homework by Thursday at the latest, but please do send it in whenever it is complete. Children will receive a set of spellings from their phonics teacher to learn at home weekly, ready for a test on Thursday.
